Today we refuse to work!

We are migrant and asylum seekers that work at the SDA warehouse. Today we strike again because we are tired of exploitation and racism inside the warehouse. These are our demands:

- All the hours of work must be paid. No more overtime hours that are not payed! We do not accept money being stolen from our meager wages. Overtime hours must meet legal limits.
- No more on-call contracts with temp agencies that only last a few days. We are tired of being called out last minute and just in time to work nights, weekends, or to fill in for people who are sick or on strike. We need to work in order to live and have a residence permit. We want stable contracts.
- We want a bonus pay for those who work the night shift. We also want meal vouchers (buoni pasto) just as all other workers.
- The 30-minute break must be paid. We do not accept that all our movements are controlled and even the minutes we leave to go to the bathroom are counted. This happens only for us, asylum seekers and temporary workers.
- We want more security. We are tired of risking every day to get hurt while working or even to die, as happened to Yaya. Yaya died because safety measures are not fulfilled in the SDA warehouse.

We must be united to make our voices heard. Without us, the warehouse stops.

Refuse to work under these conditions,

don't go to work today!
